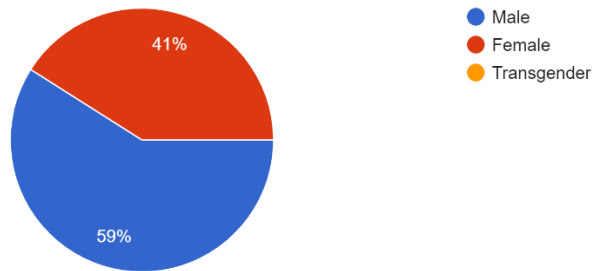

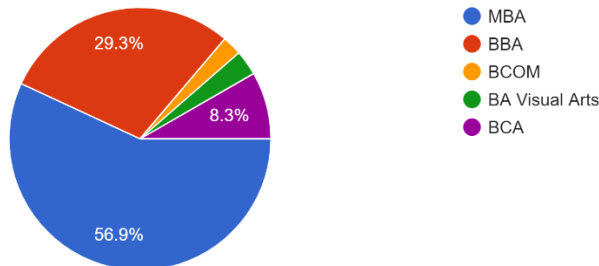

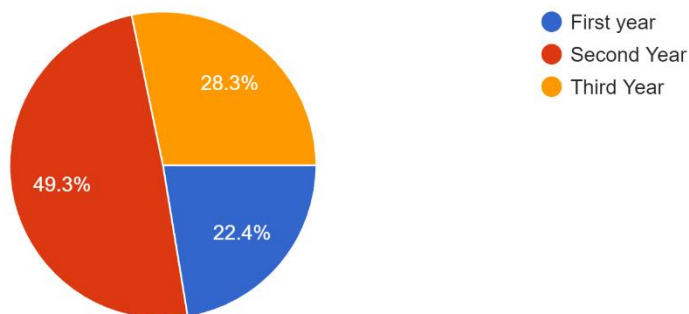
What program are you pursuing now?

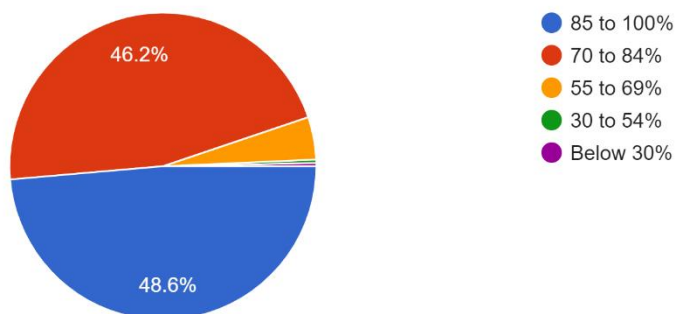

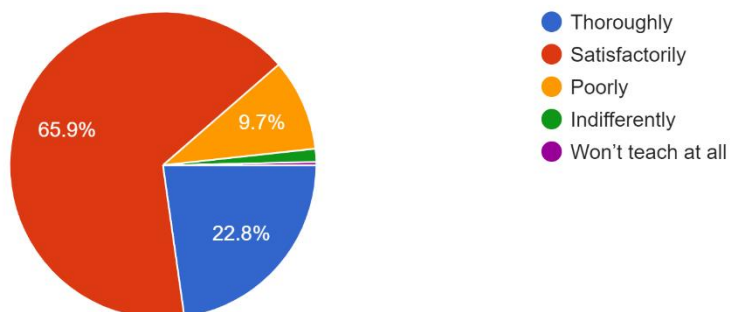
How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

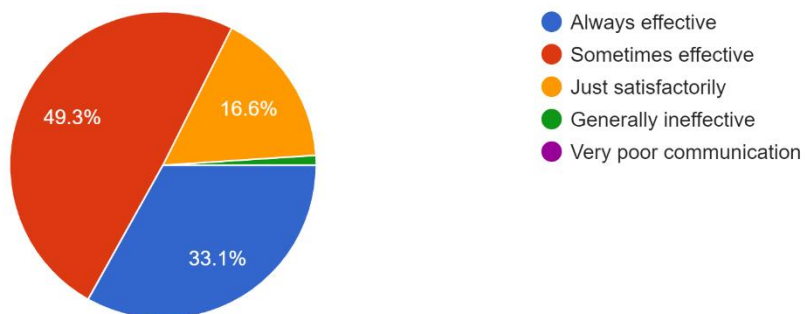

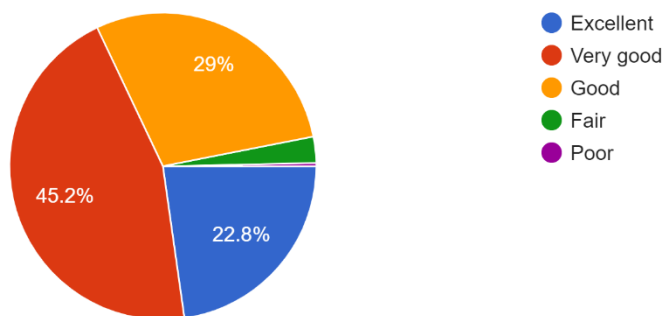

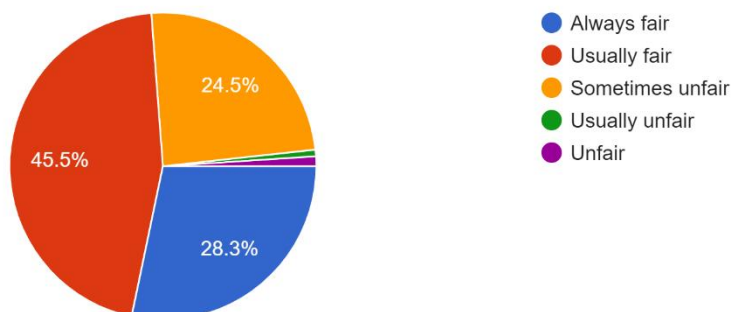

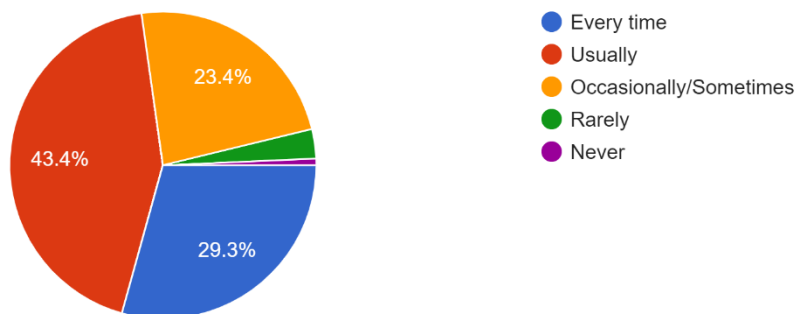

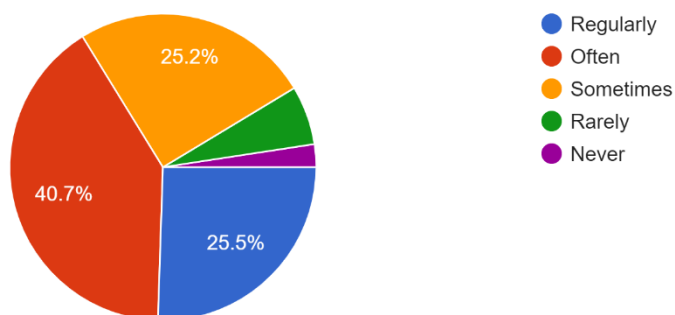

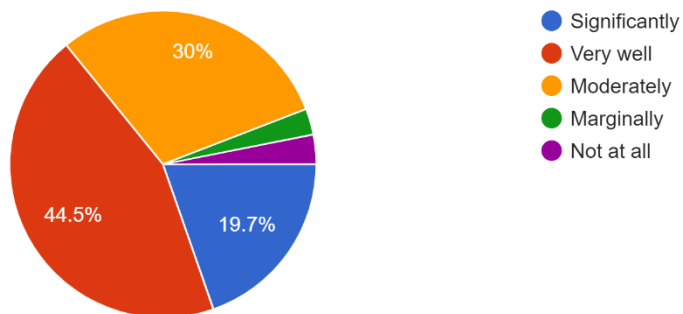

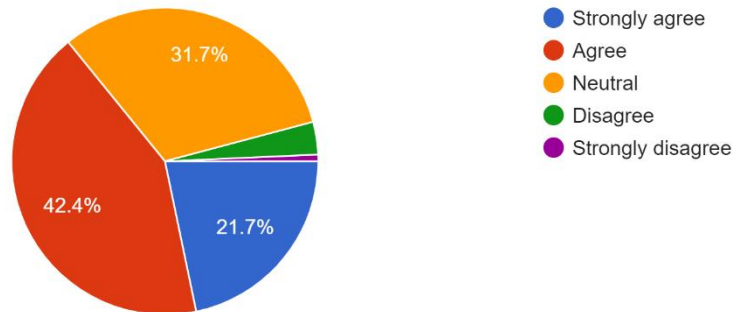

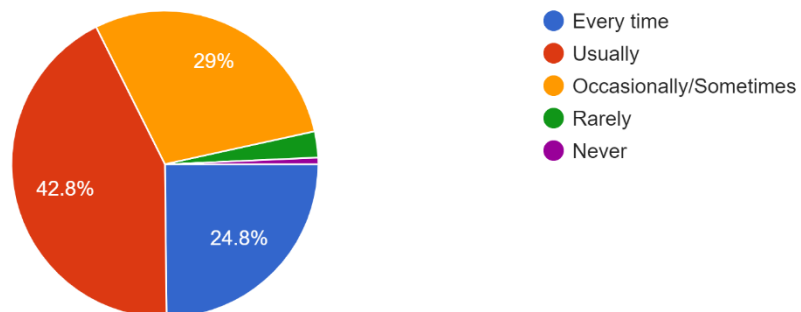

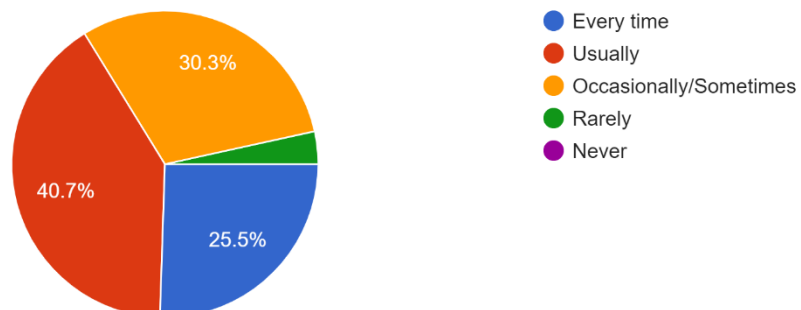

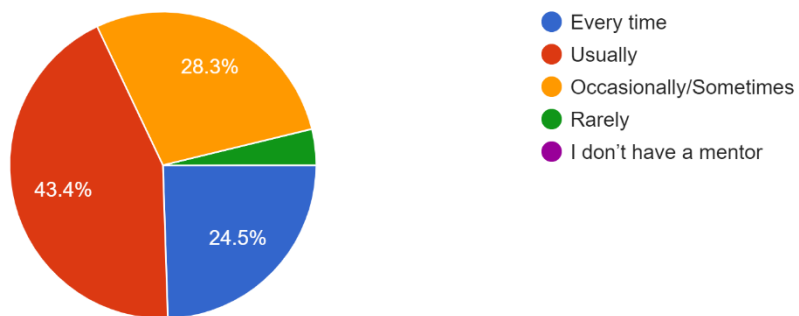

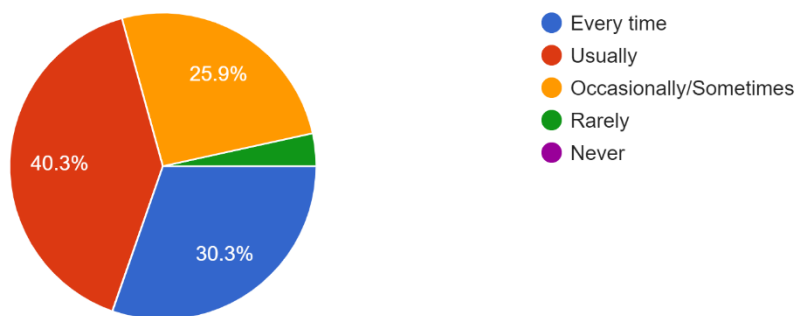

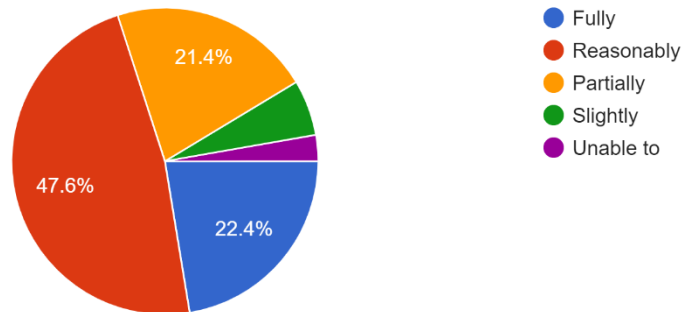

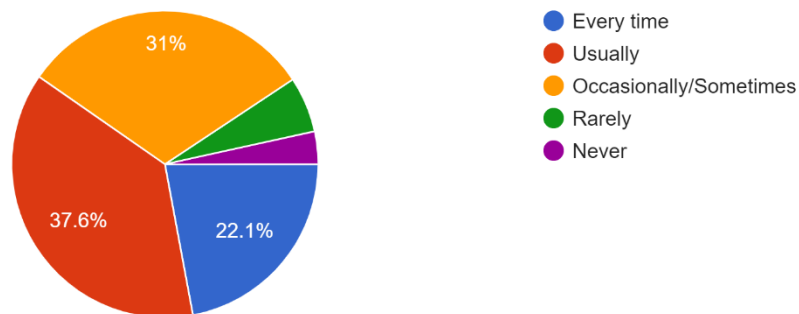

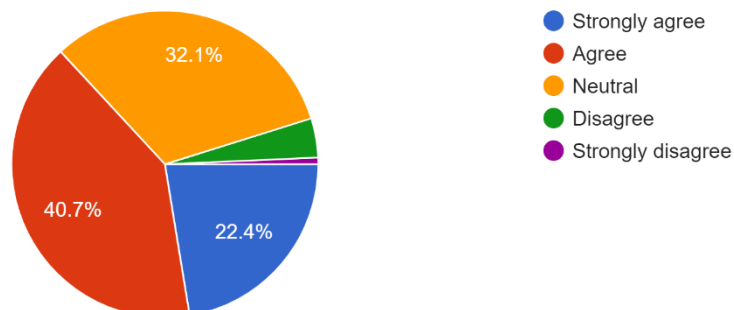

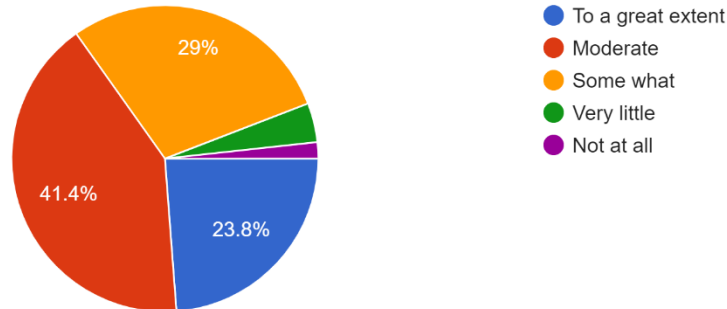

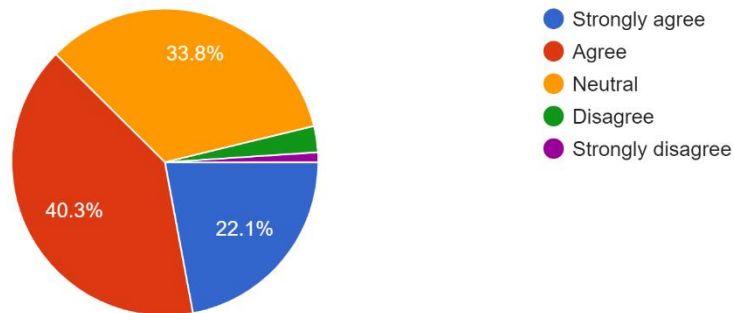

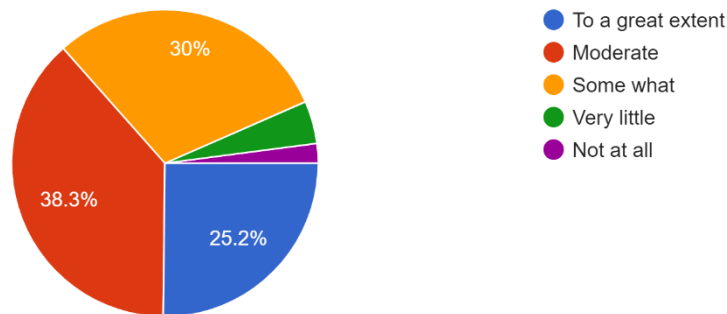

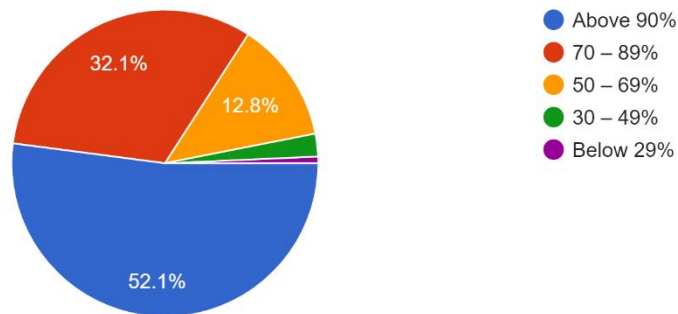
